

2009 SILVER CLASSIC OPEN TO THE WORLD FUTURITY

NOMINATION OF SIRE

1. All stallions nominated to the Open To World Futurity must be registered or listed with the AQHA, APHA, ApHC, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA, or PtHA Stud Book.
2. Stallion Nomination Fees
 - A. \$150.00 - Before June 25, 2009
 - B. \$200.00 - After June 26, 2009
3. Nomination of stallion creates eligibility for ALL ages of get to complete in the Open To World Futurity in that year only.

WEANLING DIVISION

1. The sire of each foal entered must have been nominated in the Open To World Futurity in the year of exhibition.
2. Weanling Entry Fees:
 - A. \$100 - Before June 25, 2009
 - B. \$150 - After June 26, 2009
3. The foal must be registered with the AQHA, APHA, ApHC, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA, or PtHA. Breeders certificate can be sent in with entry, you will not be paid futurity money until show office has ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE . Please try and have your colt original registration certificate by date of show.
4. The foal must be eligible for competition in corresponding breed approved shows.
5. Early and Late foals will be shown in separate classes. Must have a total of 10 foals showing day of show before we will split class between early and late. If we do not have 10 foals showing then class will not be split. Early and Late splits apply to both colts and mares, must have 10 colts showing and 10 fillies showing before we would split early and late.
6. Show management will inform all exhibitors morning of show if classes will be split between early and late colts and fillies.
7. Prize money will be split equally between early and late fillies and early and late colts. If no split occur prize money will be combined.
8. A lip chain CAN NOT BE USED ON ANY WEANLING showing in class.

TWO YEAR OLD SNAFFLE/HACKAMORE DIVISION

1. The sire of each entry must have been nominated in the Open To World Futurity in the year of exhibition.
2. Two Year Old Entry Fees:
 - A. \$100 - Before June 25, 2009
 - B. \$150 - After June 26, 2009

3. The entry must be registered with the AQHA, APHA, ApHC, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA, or PtHA.
4. The entry must have registered certificate on file with the Show Management.
5. The entry must be eligible for competition in corresponding breed approved shows.
6. NSBA rules and standards will be used for judging, scoring, and rules.
7. Judges may ask exhibitors to drop bits in class.

THREE YEAR & OLDER PLEASURE

1. The sire of each entry must have been nominated in the Open To World Futurity in the year of exhibition.
2. Junior Western Pleasure Entry Fees:
 - A. \$100 - Before June 25, 2009
 - B. \$150 - After June 26, 2009
3. Age 3 as of January 1st the year of exhibition.
4. The entry must be registered with the AQHA, APHA, ApHC, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA, or PtHA.
5. The entry must have registered certificate on file with the Show Management.
6. The entry must be eligible for competition in corresponding breed approved shows.
7. NSBA rules and standards will be used for judging, scoring, and rules.
8. Judges may ask exhibitors to drop bits in class.

NOTE: Nebraska Silver Classic Futurity would consider adding the following classes to Open To World Futurity if we get enough request from exhibitors to add the classes.
